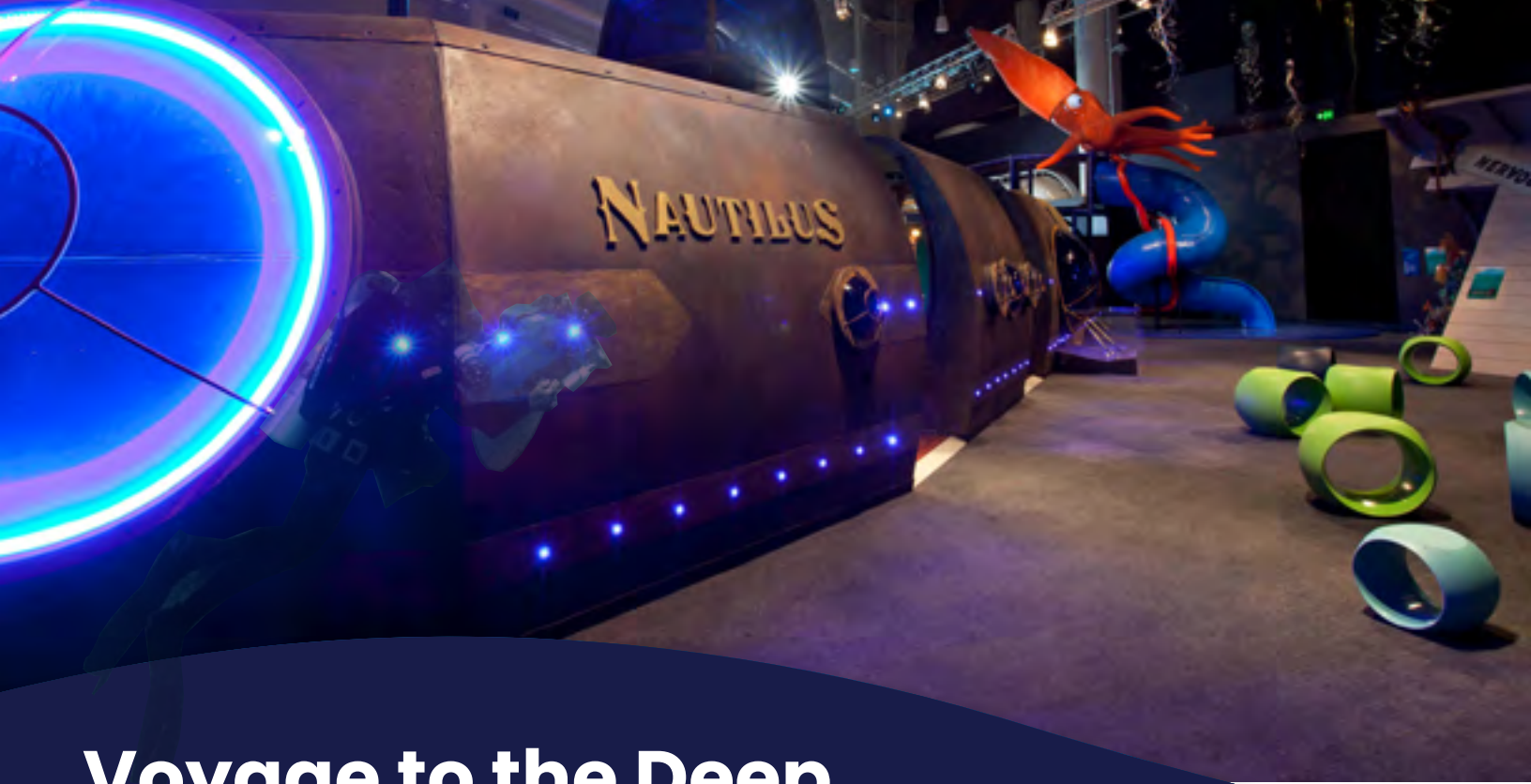

- Role-play in the Octopus's Garden with its massive clamshell
- Use the sunken city of Atlantis as a performance space
