### The life and adventures of the Venetian traveller in 17TH Century Mughal India


The show is dedicated to the story of the life and travels of Nicolò Manucci (1638-1720), a Venetian of humble origins who in November 1653, driven by the desire to explore the world, stowed away in the hold of a tartane heading from Venice to the East, never to return.



The exhibition sets out to retrace the main phases of the life of the Venetian traveller Nicolò Manucci, combining original illustrations by venitian artist Guido Fuga, reproductions and decorative elements from different eras with a selection of digital reproductions of the manuscripts, designed to show all the pages of the texts together with the richness of the colours and illustrations of a world that has now disappeared.


# THE VISITOR EXPERIENCE






